DEP BAC TAC

Draft rule should be available in about a month. FDEP will hold a stakeholder meeting.

62-160 F.A.C Quality Assurance

Maria Loucraft from Pompano Beach gave an update of the recent final rulemaking regarding 62-160.

- Bringing in The Nelac Institute (TNI) language
- Changing the version of the FDEP field SOPs
- Changing the Streams condition index references
- Allowing for private auditors
- Stating that electronic data is considered as valid as paper
- Clarifications to the FDEP qualifiers or flags
- Clarifying the definition of Method detection limit and Practical quantitation limit and allowing that some tests may not have them
- Note: The tests the operators can run remains the same, except that it now states they must follow the FDEP SOPs for field testing and calibration (I think this may be tying into the 4 log testing and calibration requirements)
- Incorporation of a new set of documents
- Incorporating the new federal methods allowed for analysis
- Enterococci analysis for the beach testing, check the new available methods. These were incorporated by reference in this rule.

NNC – Water Quality Credit Trading

RECLAIMED WATER STUDY
