Regulatory Update
November 13, 2017**

- **CFWI Rulemaking**
 - No rule development scheduled yet.

- **EPA - Waters of the United States (WOTUS)**
 - February 2017 rule was repealed; now engaged in second step notice and comment rulemaking for definition of WOTUS
 - On November 14, 2017 from 1:00 -3:00 pm, the EPA will be conducting a stakeholder session with stormwater, wastewater management and drinking water agencies regarding the revised definition of the “waters of the United States” rule.

- **Lower East Coast Water Supply Plan (LECWSP)**
 - SFWMD is beginning effort to update LECWSP – a presentation will be made at September or October meeting.
 - Currently working on demand projections
 - Modelling to follow
 - Expected to be completed in early 2018.
 - Utilities will have to update their 10-year water supply plans within 18 months of the Governing Board approval/adoption of the updated plan.
